policy statement

SCEE will ensure all of its employees, and particularly site based employees, are advised of the expected climate, flora and fauna likely to be experienced in the various local working environments.

This information shall be provided through inductions, prestart and toolbox meetings, and may cover such topics as expected temperatures; working in heat; prevention of heat exhaustion, maintaining adequate fluid intake; working at altitude; working in cold climates; working in climates with cyclonic conditions; working in areas prone to dust, high winds, rain and lightning storms; wildlife that may be encountered and specifically protected species; protected flora and national parks in the area; terrain and marine conservation areas; and heritage and indigenous areas.

Personnel protective equipment shall be provided where required for various working conditions such as shade brim hardhat attachments, water bottles, fly nets, sunscreen, gloves, UV rated clothing, safety glasses and dust masks.

Management shall encourage acclimatisation to local working environments and provide updated information and education on local environment awareness as changes are introduced.
